Rules of Play

Scratch off «YOUR SYMBOLS» («IHRE SYMBOLE»). Compare these with the symbols in «GAMES 1–4» («SPIELE 1–4») and scratch off the matching symbols.

BONUS: If you discover a **10%** in the «YOUR SYMBOLS» field, you win 10 francs instantly!

«GAMES 1–3»

- If you scratch off one or more full (horizontal and/or vertical) lines in «GAME 1–3» you can uncover the corresponding letters. To continue, see «GAME 5».
- If you uncover all the symbols in «GAME 1–3», you win the corresponding amount.

«GAME 4»

- If you uncover all the symbols in a horizontal line, you win the corresponding amount.

«GAME 5»

- In «GAME 5», scratch off the letters uncovered in «GAME 1–3».
- If you scratch off no full words or three or more full words in the crossword puzzle in accordance with the prize rules, you win the amount corresponding to the number of words in the «PRIZE DISPLAY» («PREISLEGENDE»).
- If you scratch off the «BONUS WORD» («BONUSWORT»), you win the amount shown in the corresponding «PRIZE» («GEWINN») field.

Prize rules

- A word consists of a minimum of three letters and is shown exclusively horizontally from left to right or vertically from top to bottom.
- A word is demarcated by either empty fields and/or the edge of the game area.
- A word only counts as a full word when all the letters within the depicted area are uncovered, with this word counting as one word (e.g.: SANDBOX does not count as the two words SAND and BOX)..
